As you may recall, there were a number of matters arising from the A.G.M. and these are addressed below.

1. **Dispersal of club assets** on dissolution of the club. This is presently covered by the constitution which states that: "In the event of the Committee dissolving the club, the Club assets will be held for six months to allow current members to reform the club. If by that time the Club has not been reformed then the assets of the Club will be given to the AWGB for youth development."

Your committee has met already and discussed this and we feel that this should be a topic of further discussion at the next A.G.M. This will give everyone time to consider and please make your views known to the committee.

2. **Rule change.** You confirmed at the A.G.M., the passing of a new rule regarding the number of required attendances in a year for any prospective committee member. The following wording has been added to the constitution as rule M: "Any member standing for election to the committee or office must have attended at least four club meetings in the year prior to election as evidenced by the attendance book." A draft copy of the constitution is enclosed with this newsletter. **This will be voted on at 10:00 a.m. on 5<sup>th</sup> Jan 2001.**

3. **Video and Tool Hire.** In view of the current healthy surplus at the Bank and the fact that the videos and tools have already been paid for collectively by members, we

took on board the point raised at the A.G.M. that these could be provided for free. With immediate effect, therefore, no hire fee will be payable for these items. A refundable deposit (a cheque) will be taken at the time.
