Spalted logs

Burrs

Kiln Dried Boards of Beech, Cherry, English Walnut, Black Walnut, Burred Elm, Lime, Sycamore, Oak

How to find them:-

1. A14 J7 follow the road to Stamford into Geddington (speed cameras) 3rd right to Grafton Underwood. Sawmill on the left as you leave the village.
2. A14 J11 into Cranford, 3rd right to Grafton Underwood. Into Grafton take last left for Geddington. Sawmill is on the right as you enter the village.
